## Rainbows (17-9, 11-6) End Regular Season with Series Against Pacific (10-15, 6-11)

### THIS WEEK'S SCHEDULE

This weekend's two-match series against the Pacific Tigers, marks the University of Hawai'i's final regular season matches of the 2000 season. The two teams meet Friday, April 14 and Saturday, April 15 at the Stan Sheriff Center. With a playoff berth already secured, the Rainbows hope to build momentum heading into the first round of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Tournament.

UH (17-9, 11-6) is coming off a non-conference series split with No. 10 Lewis. The 'Bows held on for a four-set victory on Friday but were shocked in the rematch on Saturday, losing in three. Since starting the MPSF season 5-6, the Rainbows have won six straight to assure themselves third place in the Pacific Division standings.

UOP (10-15, 6-11) enters the series having lost their last three matches, including seven of nine in league play, to all but eliminate them from tournament contention. At least three different scenarios must happen for the Tigers to gain one of two wild card entries into the tournament.

After Saturday's match, senior libero Russell Lockwood will be honored in the traditional senior night ceremonies. Lockwood in the lone senior on this year's squad.

**HITTING TO PERFECTION**

During UH's seven-match win streak, the Rainbows hit .433 as a team to help clinch a playoff berth in the MPSF Tournament. Hawai'i eclipsed the .400 mark in five of those matches. In a three-game sweep of Stanford (Mar. 25), the 'Bows came within .006 points of surpassing a five-year old school record for best hitting percentage in a match (.568).

**MPSF TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

Beginning this season, a new format will be implemented for the MPSF Tournament field. As selected in previous years, the top three teams from both divisions qualify as well as two "wild card" teams among the remaining eight teams. However, the eight qualifying teams will be seeded one through eight based on their final MPSF records instead of the top two teams in each division earning the top four seeds.

**STANLEY NEARING UH MILESTONES**

In two and half seasons, Clay Stanley is ready to etch his name in the UH record books. With 43 more kills, he will become just the 10th Rainbow to reach 1,000 in their career. His 82 career service aces already ranks him fifth all-time. Stanley also needs just eight aces to break the single-season mark of 54 held by Mark Presho in 1993.

**THE 'COSTAS' CLEAR FOR RAINBOWS**

Of the nine newcomers on this year's squad, the one making the most immediate impact is outside hitter Costas Theocharidis. The freshman from Greece has led the team in kills in 16 matches and owns a 6.24 kill average, ninth-best in the country. He has reached the 30-kill plateau five times, most recently a 30-kill outing against Stanford (Mar. 24).

**ITS A BIRD...NO, ITS A CONDOR**

One of the most dominating players in the collegiate game this season is junior Clay "Condor" Stanley. At 6-foot-9, Stanley has thrilled the crowd with his high-powered kills and bullet-like serves. Four times this season he has eclipsed 30 kills and his 47 service aces leads the squad. Stanley ranks 11th nationally with a 5.85 kill average and fourth in the service aces category.

**E.Z. DOES IT**

A constant on the outside for Hawai'i is freshman Eyal Zimet. The fourth Israeli to join the Rainbows under head coach Mike Wilton's reign, Zimet averages 2.46 kills, while hitting .335. One of UH's primary passers, he ranks second on the squad with a 1.75 dig average and has served 21 aces. From March 24-30, he averaged 3.94 kills, hitting .500.

## GREAT WALL OF DAVIS

At 6-foot-5, Brenton Davis stands tall in the middle of the Rainbow frontline. Considered short for middle blockers, Davis leads the league and ranks second nationally in blocking average. Seven times this season, he has recorded 10 or more blocks with a high of 14 against BYU and UC San Diego. In MPSF matches, Davis owns a staggering 2.32 average.

## ANOTHER ONE BITES THE DUST

UH's latest victory over top-ranked Pepperdine marked the team's second victory over a No. 1-ranked this season. In mid-February, the 'Bows split two-matches with Long Beach State, their victory coming in straight sets. Overall, Hawai'i has faced three No. 1 ranked teams and are 2-3 against them. Aside from the Long Beach State loss, the 'Bows split a their series with Pepperdine and UCLA (1/28).

## TORRY-FIC DEBUT

Along with Brenton Davis, Torry Tukuafu is also starting his first full season at middle blocker. The junior boasts a team-high .411 hitting percentage, placing him Top 20 nationally. Tukuafu has hit over .400 13 times, with a high of .750 against LMU (15-0-20) and Stanford (12-0-16). In the last four weeks, Tukuafu switched to outside hitter where he is averaging 6.13 kills, hitting .384.

## 'LIBERO' MEANS LOCKWOOD

With outstanding defensive efforts this season, Russell Lockwood has defined the meaning of libero. The position, which is making its debut in the 2000 collegiate season scene, allows each coach to designate a player as a backrow specialist. Lockwood leads the team with a 2.59 dig average which ranks Top 5 nationally.

## THE ROAD TO SUCCESS

UH made three regular season road trips this season, sweeping two. In February, the Rainbows swept three against LMU, Cal State Northridge, and UC Santa Barbara. Two weeks ago, UH took all four matches against San Diego State and UC San Diego. Hawai'i is 7-2 on the road this season.

## SERVING IT TOUGH

Through 26 matches, the Rainbows have put together lethal performances at the service line. The 'Bows have nailed 159 aces averaging 1.67 per game. Clay Stanley leads the team with 47, ranking third in the country. He served up a career-high six aces against Loyola-Chicago (Jan. 14) and on four other occasions, had four aces.

## NO PLACE LIKE HOME

In its sixth year calling the Stan Sheriff Center home, the Rainbows have a stellar 83-20 (.806) record in the facility. In 1999, UH posted a 16-2 record, its best since the NCAA runner-up year of 1996. Hawai'i has led the nation each of the last five years.

## Head Coach Mike Wilton

Mike Wilton, the winningest coach in the Hawai'i men's volleyball history, is in his eighth year at the Manoa campus. Among his impressive credentials as the Rainbow skipper are guiding his teams to back-to-back NCAA Championship appearances (1995-96) and capturing three Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Pacific Division crowns, while compiling a 155-71 career mark at Hawai'i.

In 1995, behind the arm of NCAA Player-of-the-Year Yuval Katz, his team won the program's first-ever conference title and, in the process, earned him Tachikara National Coach-of-the-Year and MPSF Coach-of-the-Year honors. The following year, his team ended their season with a perfect 19-0 conference record and a second place finish in the NCAA Championships in Los Angeles.

Under his tenure, Wilton's teams have never suffered through a losing season and have posted two 20-win campaigns. Among the many players filing through Wilton's system are seven All-Americans and 14 all-league performers.

HONOLULU - With momentum shifting the other way, Hawai'i held on for a 15-4, 15-4, 5-15, 15-13 victory over No. 10 Lewis, Friday night. The Rainbows avoided a rally-scoring fifth game when freshman Costas Theocharidis nailed two crucial service aces, with the score tied at 13 in the fourth set, to end the match.

Leading the Rainbow charge was Theocharidis and Torry Tukuafu, who each pounded 23 kills. Theocharidis also recorded four aces, seven digs, and six blocks while Tukuafu, playing in his sixth consecutive match at outside hitter, added 11 digs. Clay Stanley, who started his first match at middle blocker, slammed 12 kills and was in on a career-best eight blocks.

Setter Stefan Krejci continued his inspiring play in directing the Rainbow offense. As a team, Hawai'i hit .357 and four starters had double-figure kills with hitting percentages of over .350.

HONOLULU - One night after nearly letting a two game lead disappear, Hawai'i suffered a close three-game defeat to the hands of No. 10 Lewis, 15-12, 15-12, 15-12, Saturday night. The Rainbows saw their seven-match win streak come to an end as they fell to 17-9 overall.

For the 'Bows, Theocharidis finished the night with 28 kills, hitting .417, eight digs, seven blocks and three aces. Tukuafu added 14 kills and Stanley had 11 kills and four blocks.
