Goo Closing in On 300

Head coach Vince Goo is nearing a milestone, needing only four more wins to reach 300 victories in his career. Goo, who took over the reins at UH during the 1987-88 season, holds a 296-126 (.701) in his 15th year as head coach. Goo picked up his 100th win on December 13, 1992 vs. Santa Clara and his 200th in a win over Rice in the quarterfinals of the WAC Tournament on March 5, 1997. Goo began this season with 287 wins. His teams have averaged 20.5 wins per season.

Winning at the Line

UH has made a living on the line, where the Wahine have nearly doubled the amount of free throw attempts of its opponents. UH has gone to the line 303 times in the first 11 games, an average of 27.5 per game. In UH's 82-59 win over Charlotte (Dec. 17) the Wahine converted on a season-high 28-of-44 free throws. Their opponents meanwhile have taken 154 foul shots, an average of 14.0 per game. The Wahine have continued to stay out of foul trouble, with only two disqualifications this season and three in the last 45 contests.

Sharing the Wealth

The Wahine have learned that it's better to give than to receive. Hawaii leads the conference in assists at 16.1 per game with 68.6 percent of the team's 258 field goals coming off assists. Senior point guard **Janka Gabrielova** leads the team and is second in the WAC with 4.64 per game. **April Atuaia** has led the team in assists a team-high six times and is second in the category, averaging 4.18 per game.

Return to Sender

Junior **Christen Roper** has continued to dominate the paint defensively. The 6-5 center, who set a school and conference single-season record of 96 blocks last season, is on another record-setting pace with 42 blocks through 11 games. Her 3.9 bpg ranks first in conference and second in the nation (Dec. 17). She already tied a school-record with seven blocks in the season-opener vs. Washington State (Nov. 17) and became the school's all-time leader in blocked shots against Baylor (Dec. 7) five games later. While **Nani Cockett** (1994, '96-'98) set the mark of 140 in 120 career games, Roper shattered the record in just 62 contests. She now has a career total of 160.

Tenacious D

The Wahine, among the national leaders in defense last season, are again putting the clamps down on their opponents. UH is allowing just 58.9 points per game and have held its opponents to just 33.5 percent shooting from the floor. UH held Cleveland State to just 17-of-71 shooting (24 percent) in its last non-conference outing. Even in defeat the Wahine put out a solid defensive effort. Stanford defeated UH 71-60, but shot just 39 percent and was held scoreless by the Wahine for more than 10 minutes in the first half.

Going Postal

Hawai'i's first 11 opponents have found the going tough in the post. The Wahine frontcourt combination of **Natasja Allen** and **Christen Roper** have come up huge on both ends of the court accounting for 38 percent of the team's scoring and 32 percent of the rebounding. Allen is averaging a team best 14.6 ppg and adding 6.3 rpg. Roper is second on the team with 12.5 ppg and is second in rebounds at 7.9 per game. Roper was named MVP of the Waikiki Beach Marriott Resort Classic and Ala Moana Hotel Paradise Classic after leading the Wahine to the championship. She was also named WAC Player of the Week on December 28. Allen, meanwhile, earned all-tournament honors in all four of UH's preseason tourneys and has scored in double figures in 10 of 11 games this year.

Injury Update

Freshman forward **Jade Abele** will return to practice on Thursday and is questionable for this week's games versus SMU and Louisiana Tech. Abele has been sidelined the last six games with a stress fracture in her right foot.

Movin' On Up

Hawai'i is ranked 31st in the latest (January 31) ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll.

The Wahine, who have won six in a row, received 25 votes.

RPI Ratings

Hawai'i ranks 26th (strength of schedule #55) by CollegeRpi.com and 26th (strength of schedule #48) by *Collegiate Basketball News* in the latest RPI ratings. The Wahine are ranked 27th (strength of schedule #82) by WBCA/Summerville.

Home Sweet Home

Since moving into the Stan Sheriff Center in 1994, Hawai'i has won 76 percent of its home games (104-34) and 80 percent of its conference games (45-11). The Wahine held an 11-game home win streak until falling to Stanford, November 24.

Road Warriors

The Wahine are 27-11 (.715) in Western Athletic Conference regular season road games since joining the league in 1996-97.

Top-Notch Schedule

Hawai'i will face up to three ranked teams during its regular season schedule and have already hung tough against its first two ranked foes. The Wahine lost its first matchup with a ranked team when it fell to Stanford (then AP No. 8, Coaches' No. 7), 71-60, in the semi-finals of the Rainbow Wahine Classic. The Wahine trailed by as many as 19 in the game but went on a 21-0 run to go ahead of the Cardinal before the half. The game was knotted halfway through the second half, until Stanford pulled away. UH also presented a challenge for Baylor (then AP No. 9, Coaches' No. 13) in the Tesoro Invitational on Dec. 7. The Wahine trailed by just two points at half and led by as many as three points in the second half, before falling, 60-55. Louisiana Tech (AP No. 11, Coaches' No. 13) looms in conference play on January 13 (home) and February 7th (away).

Up Next

Hawai'i departs on its second road trip of the season, traveling to Rice (January 17, 7 p.m. CST) and Tulsa (January 19, 2 p.m. CST).

The Lady Mustangs, picked third in the WAC Coaches Preseason Poll, have gotten off to a slow start losing its first three conference games before defeating Boise State at home 62-56 on Saturday...the win gave head coach **Rhonda Rompola** her 200th career victory...the Lady Mustangs are led by three players in double figures, **Andrea Cossey** (12.5 ppg), **Kaci Alexander** (11.1) and **Kenni Patton** (10.6)...SMU is 2-5 away from home this season...head coach Rhonda Rompola is in her 11th season at SMU and has a 200-111 career record.

Series History

Hawai'i leads the series 9-1 and has won the last four meetings. The teams last met March 19 in the semifinals of the 2001 WAC Tournament in Tulsa, Okla., with UH pulling off a 97-88 overtime win.

The Lady Techsters have won seven straight and have gotten off to a 4-0 season in their first season in the WAC...La Tech, ranked 13th in the Coaches Poll and 11th in the AP Poll, plays at San Jose State on Thursday before traveling to the islands...Louisiana Tech has dominated the conference thus far, scoring 93.0 ppg with an average margin of victory of nearly 40 points...All-American center **Ayana Walker** leads the team with 13.8 ppg and 8.7 rpg... head coach **Leon Barmore** is in his 20th season at Louisiana Tech where he is 560-85.

Head Coach Vince Goo

Vince Goo is in his 15th season as head coach of the University of Hawai'i women's basketball team. With a 296-126 record, Goo is the winningest coach in Wahine basketball history.

Goo has brought the Wahine basketball program to unprecedented success, notching 20-plus win seasons in eight of the last 10 seasons. During his tenure, the Wahine have captured three regular-season conference titles and five NCAA Tournament and three WNIT bids.

In 1998 he was named the WAC Pacific Division Coach-of-the-Year after guiding the Wahine to the WAC Pacific Division title and an NCAA Tournament berth. He was also named Big West Coach-of-the-Year in 1989, '93 and '94.

The former high school teacher has also molded Wahine players into winners off the court. Goo boasts a 100 percent graduation rate among the more than 30 players who have completed their eligibility at UH. Last season, five Wahine made the WAC All-Academic Team.
