### Goo Closing in On 300

Head coach **Vince Goo** is nearing a milestone, needing only two more wins to reach 300 victories in his career. Goo, who took over the reins at UH during the 1987-88 season, holds a 298-128 (.700) in his 15th year as head coach. Goo picked up his 100th win on December 13, 1992 vs. Santa Clara and his 200th in a win over Rice in the quarterfinals of the WAC Tournament on March 5, 1997. Goo began this season with 287 wins. His teams have averaged 20.5 wins per season.

### Wahine Break Out

Hawaii broke out of its recent shooting woes with an offensive explosion at Tulsa. Coming into the game against Tulsa, the Wahine were in a three-game slump, averaging 20 points below their season average of 70 points per game. UH was 1-2 during the stretch and shooting just 31 percent, including a 10-of-50 performance (20 percent) at Rice. Against Rice the Wahine failed to make a 3-point shot for just the third time in the last four seasons. UH responded two days later by hitting seven straight 3-pointers in the first half alone at Tulsa. UH scored 42 first half points, shooting 58 percent while finished the game at a 46 percent clip. The Wahine also made 9-of-10 free throws after shooting just 32-of-52 (62 percent) in back-to-back losses to Louisiana Tech and Rice.

### Crashing the Boards

Rebounding has been one of the keys to UH's success thus far. Hawaii has out-rebounded 11 of 15 opponents and are 11-1 when holding and advantage on the boards. The Wahine currently rank second in the WAC and 16th in the nation in rebound margin at +8.1. Junior center **Christen Roper** (8.1 rpg) and sophomore guard **April Atuaia** (7.3 rpg) led the way on the glass.

### Winning at the Line

UH has made a living on the line, where the Wahine have nearly doubled the amount of free throw attempts of their opponents. UH has gone to the line 377 times in 15 games, an average of 25.1 per game. Their opponents meanwhile have averaged 13.5 attempts per game. The Wahine have in fact made more free throws than their opponents have attempted (255-203). They have also continued to stay out of foul trouble, with only three disqualifications this season and four in the last 48 contests.

### Return to Sender

Junior **Christen Roper** has continued to dominate the paint defensively. The 6-5 center, who set a school and conference single-season record of 96 blocks last season, is on another record-setting pace with 49 blocks through 15 games. Her 3.3 bpg ranks first in conference and fifth in the nation. She already tied a school-record with seven blocks in the season-opener vs. Washington State (Nov. 17) and became the school's all-time leader in blocked shots against Baylor (Dec. 7) five games later. While **Nani Cockett** (1994, '96-98) set the mark of 140 in 120 career games, Roper shattered the record in just 62 contests. She now has a career total of 167.

### They Don't Play Like Freshman

Reserves **Jade Abele**, **Chelsea Wagner** and **Kim Willoughby** have sparked the Wahine with their fearless play. Abele returned from a stress fracture in her right foot to give a depleted Wahine frontline a boost in UH's 52-51 win over SMU (Jan. 11). The native of Gold Coast, Australia finished with eight points and a season-high seven rebounds. Wagner meanwhile is starting to come on, scoring in double digits in three of the last four games. She was crucial in UH's win over SMU with a career-high 13 points. Willoughby, who joined the team in December following an All-American volleyball season, has gotten into the basketball groove recording her first double-double with 16 points and 15 rebounds versus San Jose State (Jan. 5). She is averaging 6.9 ppg and 5.7 rpg in seven games.

### Tenacious D

The Wahine, among the national leaders in defense last season, are again putting the clamps down on their opponents. UH is allowing just 58.3 points per game (24th in the nation) and have held its opponents to just 33.6 percent shooting from the floor (2nd in the nation). Just one opponent in the last 54 games has shot 50 percent against UH (New Mexico, March 24, 2001). Even in defeat the Wahine put out a solid defensive effort. Stanford defeated UH 71-60, but shot just 39 percent and was held scoreless by the Wahine for more than 10 minutes in the first half.

### Going Postal

Hawaii's first 15 opponents have found the going tough in the post. The Wahine

frontcourt combination of **Natasja Allen** and **Christen Roper** have come up huge on both ends of the court. Allen is averaging a team best 12.7 ppg and adding 5.9 rpg. Roper is second on the team with 10.9 ppg and is first in rebounds at 8.1 per game. Roper was named MVP of the Waikiki Beach Marriott Resort Classic and Ala Moana Hotel Paradise Classic after leading the Wahine to the championship. She was also named WAC Player of the Week on December 28. Allen, meanwhile, earned all-tournament honors in all four of UH's preseason tourneys and has scored in double figures in 12 of 15 games this year.

## RPI Ratings

Hawai'i ranks 42nd (strength of schedule #73) by CollegeRpi.com and 43rd (strength of schedule #60) by *Collegiate Basketball News* in the latest RPI ratings. The Wahine are ranked 44th (strength of schedule #97) by WBCA/Summerville.

## Home Sweet Home

Since moving into the Stan Sheriff Center in 1994, Hawai'i has won 75 percent of its home games (105-35) and 79 percent of its conference games (46-12). The Wahine held an 11-game home win streak until falling to Stanford, November 24.

## Road Warriors

The Wahine are 28-12 (.700) in Western Athletic Conference regular season road games since joining the league in 1996-97.

## Top-Notch Schedule

Hawai'i has faced three ranked teams during its regular season schedule and have hung tough against all of them. The Wahine lost its first matchup with a ranked team when it fell to **Stanford** (then AP No. 8, Coaches' No. 7), 71-60, in the semifinals of the Rainbow Wahine Classic. The Wahine trailed by as many as 19 in the game but went on a 21-0 run to go ahead of the Cardinal before the half. The game was knotted halfway through the second half, until Stanford pulled away. UH also presented a challenge for **Baylor** (then AP No. 9, Coaches' No. 13) in the Tesoro Invitational on Dec. 7. The Wahine trailed by just two points at half and led by as many as three points in the second half, before falling, 60-55. In a conference matchup up on January 13, UH lost to **Louisiana Tech** (then AP No. 11, Coaches' No. 13), 67-55. Before facing the Wahine, the Lady Techsters average margin of victory in the WAC was near 40 points. UH came within nine points in the second half and held Louisiana Tech 25 points below its conference scoring average.

## Up Next

Hawai'i plays four straight road games starting with San Jose State on February 2 at 5:30 p.m. PST. The Wahine then travel to El Paso on February 4, where they will play UTEP at 7 p.m. MST in a game originally scheduled for December 30. The game was postponed due to travel difficulties for the Wahine. UH rounds out the trip at Louisiana Tech (February 7, 6 p.m. CST) and at SMU (February 9, 2 p.m. MST).

**Lindsay Logan** (16.8 ppg, 4.6 apg) and junior forward **Omelego Udeze** (12.2, 7.6 rpg)...Aiea high school graduate **Aritta Lane** is averaging 10.0 ppg and 8.5 rpg, the latter number placing her third in the WAC...head coach **Britt King** is in her fourth season at Fresno where she is 37-65. Her career record is 111-140 in 10 seasons.

## Head Coach Vince Goo

Vince Goo is in his 15th season as head coach of the University of Hawai'i women's basketball team. With a 298-128 record, Goo is the winningest coach in Wahine basketball history.

Goo has brought the Wahine basketball program to unprecedented success, notching 20-plus win seasons in eight of the last 10 seasons. During his tenure, the Wahine have captured three regular-season conference titles and five NCAA Tournament and three WNIT bids.

In 1998 he was named the WAC Pacific Division Coach-of-the-Year after guiding the Wahine to the WAC Pacific Division title and an NCAA Tournament berth. He was also named Big West Coach-of-the-Year in 1989, '93 and '94.

The former high school teacher has also molded Wahine players into winners off the court. Goo boasts a 100 percent graduation rate among the more than 30 players who have completed their eligibility at UH. Last season, five Wahine made the WAC All-Academic Team.
